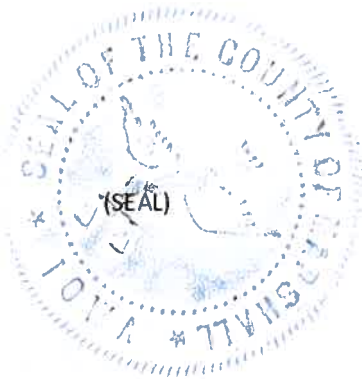



Summary: To authorize imposition of a local sales and services tax in the City of Laurel, Iowa at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2025.

A LOCAL SALES AND SERVICES TAX shall be imposed in the City of Laurel, county of Marshall, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2025, until repealed by ballot vote of the qualified electors of the incorporated area of the City of Laurel, Iowa, at a regular city election.

Revenues from the sales and services tax are to be allocated in the City of Laurel, County of Marshall, as follows:

1. Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief
2. Fifty percent (50%) to be used for the continuation of the maintenance of streets and alleys and the continuation of the maintenance operations of the streets and alleys department within the City of Laurel, Iowa.
3. Fifty percent (50%) to be used in the General Fund for any lawful purpose of the City of Laurel, Iowa

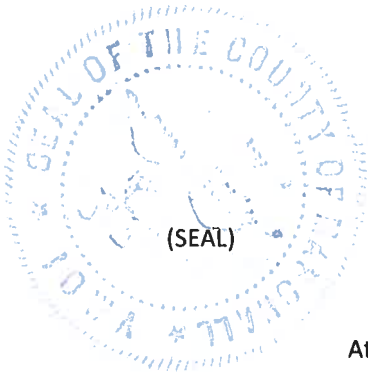

78% for property tax relief

22% any lawful purpose as authorized by the City Council

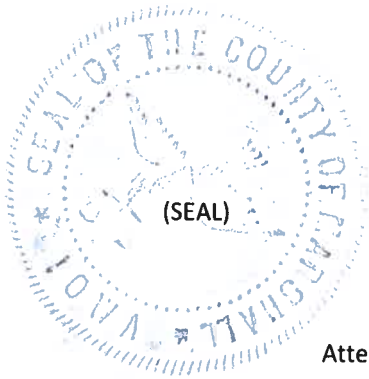
